Unit owners, with board approval, may install code approved EV (electric vehicle) chargers in their parking spaces. The major cost of bringing sufficient additional power to the building has already been paid so the unit owner will only be responsible for paying for the cost of the charger installation including bringing a power line to his parking space from the building's power source. Additionally, the unit owner will be separately metered and billed for power usage. The owner will also be responsible for any other costs associated with the charger.

Interested owners should check costs and installation procedures with SDG&E and present a required proposal to the HOA board before proceeding.

Currently there are no EV chargers in unit 15 parking spaces.
