I, Steve Scharn, owner, of the 28.5497 acre tract described in the above and foregoing map of **COW CREEK CROSSING**, do hereby make and establish said subdivision and development plat of said property according to all lines, dedications, restrictions and notations on said maps or plat and hereby dedicate to the use of the public forever, all streets (except those streets designated as private streets), alleys, parks, water courses, drains, easements and public places shown thereon for the purposes and considerations therein expressed; and do hereby bind ourselves, our heirs and assigns to warrant and forever defend the title to the land so dedicated.

FURTHER, we do hereby dedicate for public utility purposes an unobstructed aerial easement five (5) feet in width from a plane twenty (20) feet above the ground level upward, located adjacent to all public utility easements shown hereon.

FURTHER, I (or we) do hereby declare that all parcels of land designated as lots on this plat are intended for the construction of single family residential dwelling units thereon (or the placement of mobile homes) and shall be restricted for same under the terms and conditions of such restrictions filed separately.

FURTHER, we do hereby covenant and agree that all of the property within the boundaries of this plat shall be restricted to prevent the drainage of any septic tanks into any public or private street, road or alley or any drainage ditch, either directly or indirectly.

FURTHER, we do hereby dedicate to the public a strip of land twenty (20) feet wide on each side of the center line of any and all bayous, creeks, gullies, ravines, draws and drainage ditches located in said subdivision, as easements for drainage purposes. Fort Bend County or any other governmental agency shall have the right to enter upon said easement at any and all times for the purposes of construction and maintenance of drainage facilities and structures.

FURTHER, we do hereby covenant and agree that all of the property within the boundaries of this subdivision and adjacent to any drainage easement, ditch, gully, creek or natural drainage way shall hereby be restricted to keep such drainage ways and easements clear of fences, buildings, excessive vegetation and other obstructions to the operations and maintenance of the drainage facility and that such abutting property shall not be permitted to drain directly into this easement except by means of an approved drainage structure.

FURTHER, Owners have dedicated and by these presents do dedicate to the use of the public utility purposes forever unobstructed aerial easements. The aerial easements shall extend horizontally an additional eleven feet, six inches (11'-6") for ten feet (10'-0") perimeter easements or seven feet, six inches (7'-6") for fourteen feet (14'-0") perimeter easements or five feet, six inches (5'-6") for sixteen feet (16'-0") perimeter easements from a plane sixteen feet (16'-0") above the ground level upward, located adjacent to and adjoining said public utility easement that are designated with aerial easements (U.E. & A.E.) as indicated and depicted, hereon, whereby the aerial easement totals twenty one foot, six inches (21'-6") in width.

FURTHER, Owners have dedicated and by these presents do dedicate to the use of the public for public utility purpose forever unobstructed aerial easements. The aerial easements shall extend horizontally an additional ten feet (10'-0") for ten feet (10'-0") back-to-back easements, or eight feet (8'-0") for fourteen feet (14'-0") back-to-back easements or seven feet (7'-0") for sixteen feet (16'-0") back-to-back easements, from a plane sixteen feet (16'-0") above ground level upward, located adjacent to both sides and adjoining said public utility easements that are designated with aerial easements (U.E. & A.E.) as indicated and depicted hereon, whereby the aerial easement totals thirty feet (30'-0") in width.

FURTHER, Owner does hereby acknowledge the receipt for the "Order for Regulation of Outdoor Lighting in the Unincorporated Areas of Fort Bend County, Texas" and do hereby covenant and agree and shall comply with this order as adopted by Fort Bend County Commissioners Court on March 23, 2004, and any subsequent amendments.

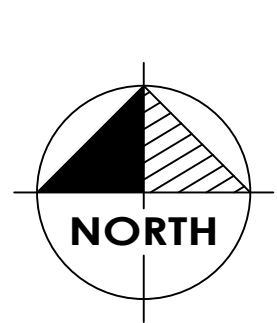

3. ACCORDING TO FEMA FLOOD INSURANCE RATE MAP (FIRM) NO. 48157C0575L & 48157C0550L, MAP REVISED APRIL 2, 2014, THE SURVEYED TRACT LIES IN ZONE "X" (PORTION IN UNSHADED & SHADED).
4. CONTOURS REPRESENT EXISTING NATURAL GROUND AS REFLECTED ON THE FORT BEND COUNTY LIDAR 2014.
5. THIS PROPERTY LIES WITHIN FORT BEND COUNTY LIGHTING ZONE L2-1 ACCORDING TO THE "ORDERS FOR REGULATION OF OUTDOOR LIGHTING".
6. ONE HALF (1/2) INCH IRON RODS THREE FEET (3') IN LENGTH WITH PLASTIC CAP SAYING "RPLS 15354035" WILL BE SET ON ALL PERIMETER BOUNDARY CORNERS SHOWN AS "SET", UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED.
7. THE DRAINAGE SYSTEM FOR THIS SUBDIVISION IS DESIGNED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE FORT BEND COUNTY DRAINAGE CRITERIA MANUAL, WHICH ALLOWS STREET PONDING WITH INTENSE RAINFALL EVENTS.
8. ABSENT WRITTEN AUTHORIZATION BY THE AFFECTED UTILITIES, ALL UTILITY AND AERIAL EASEMENTS MUST BE KEPT UNOBSTRUCTED FROM ANY NON-UTILITY IMPROVEMENTS OR OBSTRUCTIONS BY THE PROPERTY OWNER. ANY UNAUTHORIZED IMPROVEMENTS OR OBSTRUCTIONS MAY BE REMOVED BY ANY PUBLIC UTILITY AT THE PROPERTY OWNERS' EXPENSE. WHILE WOODEN POSTS AND paneled WOODEN FENCES ALONG THE PERIMETER AND BACK TO BACK EASEMENTS AND ALONGSIDE REAR LOT LINES ARE PERMITTED, THEY TOO MAY BE REMOVED BY PUBLIC UTILITIES AT THE PROPERTY OWNERS' EXPENSE SHOULD THEY BE AN OBSTRUCTION. PUBLIC UTILITIES MAY PUT SAID WOODEN POSTS AND paneled WOOD FENCES BACK UP, BUT GENERALLY WILL NOT REPLACE WITH NEW FENCINGS.
9. ALL DRAINAGE EASEMENTS TO BE KEPT CLEAR OF FENCES, BUILDINGS, VEGETATION AND OTHER OBSTRUCTIONS TO THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE DRAINAGE FACILITY.
10. THE TOP OF ALL FLOOR SLABS SHALL BE A MINIMUM OF 56.00' FEET ABOVE MEAN SEA LEVEL (NAVD83 DATUM). IN ADDITION, NO TOP OF SLAB ELEVATION SHALL BE LESS THAN 24 INCHES ABOVE THE LOWEST TOP OF CURB ADJACENT TO THE LOT IN WHICH IT LIES. IN THE ABSENCE OF A CURB, THE TOP OF SLAB ELEVATION SHALL BE NO LESS THAN 24 INCHES ABOVE THE HIGHEST NATURAL GROUND ALONG THE PERIMETER OF THE BUILDING FOUNDATION AND 12 INCHES ABOVE ANY DOWN GRADIENT ROADWAY OR DRAINAGE RESTRAINT, MAX PONDING, OR SHEET FLOW ELEVATION; AND NO LESS THAN 24 INCHES ABOVE THE 100-YEAR WSEL OF ANY DETENTION POND SERVING THE DEVELOPMENT AS TO BE DETERMINED DURING FUTURE SITE DESIGNS.
11. THERE ARE NO EXISTING PIPELINES OR PIPELINE EASEMENTS WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE PROPOSED SUBDIVISION.
12. ALL PROPERTY TO DRAIN INTO THE DRAINAGE EASEMENT ONLY THROUGH AN APPROVED DRAINAGE STRUCTURE.
13. SITE PLANS SHALL BE SUBMITTED TO FORT BEND COUNTY AND ANY OTHER APPLICABLE JURISDICTION FOR REVIEW AND APPROVAL TO OBTAIN A DEVELOPMENT PERMIT. DEVELOPMENT PERMITS AND ALL OTHER APPLICABLE PERMITS SHALL BE OBTAINED FROM FORT BEND COUNTY PRIOR TO BEGINNING CONSTRUCTION.
14. A MINIMUM DISTANCE OF 10' SHALL BE MAINTAINED BETWEEN RESIDENTIAL DWELLINGS. SIDEWALKS SHALL BE BUILT OR CAUSED TO BE BUILT NOT LESS THAN 5 FEET IN WIDTH ON BOTH SIDES OF ALL DEDICATED RIGHTS-OF-WAY WITHIN SAID PLAT AND ON THE CONTIGUOUS RIGHT-OF-WAY OF ALL PERIMETER ROADS SURROUNDING SAID PLAT, IN ACCORDANCE WITH A.D.A.
15. FORT BEND COUNTY WILL NOT ACCEPT OR MAINTAIN THE ROADS UNLESS THEY MEET THE COUNTY STANDARDS IN EFFECT ON THE DATE OF ACCEPTANCE.
16. PRIVATE ROADS WILL BE MAINTAINED IN PERPETUITY BY THE OWNERS IN THE SUBDIVISION, AND MUST CONTAIN A MECHANISM FOR ASSESSING THE OWNERS TO PRODUCE ADEQUATE REVENUE FOR PERPETUAL MAINTENANCE.
17. INDIVIDUAL LOT OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR PERMITTING OF ON-SITE SEWAGE FACILITY (OSSF) FOR SEWAGE DISPOSAL. INDIVIDUAL OSSF SYSTEM SELECTION WILL BE MADE IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE SITE EVALUATION WITH RESPECT TO THE INDIVIDUAL SITE PERMITTING PROCESS, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE 30 TAC CHAPTER 284 OSSF RULES. MAINTENANCE OF THE PRIVATE ACCESS AND DRAINAGE EASEMENTS DEDICATED HEREON IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PROPERTY OWNER, THEIR HEIRS, SUCCESSORS, OR ASSIGNS. PRIOR TO SELLING LOTS TO SUBSEQUENT OWNERS, AN OWNERS' ASSOCIATION SHALL BE ESTABLISHED TO PROVIDE FOR THE ONGOING MAINTENANCE OF ALL COMMON AREAS.
18. THIS RURAL SUBDIVISION EMPLOYS A NATURAL DRAINAGE SYSTEM WHICH IS INTENDED TO PROVIDE DRAINAGE FOR THE SUBDIVISION THAT IS SIMILAR TO THAT WHICH EXISTED UNDER PRE-DEVELOPMENT CONDITIONS. THIS, DURING LARGE STORM EVENTS, PONDING OF WATER SHOULD BE EXPECTED TO OCCUR IN THE SUBDIVISION TO THE EXTENT IT MAY HAVE PRIOR TO DEVELOPMENT, BUT SUCH PONDING SHOULD NOT REMAIN FOR AN EXTENDED PERIOD OF TIME.
19. THE USAGE OF ALL LOTS ARE RESTRICTED TO SINGLE-FAMILY USE ONLY.
20. LAND USE WITHIN THIS SUBDIVISION IS LIMITED TO AN AVERAGE IMPERVIOUSNESS OF NO MORE THAN 5%. IF THIS PERCENTAGE IS TO BE EXCEEDED A REPLAT AND/OR FURTHER DESIGN OF A DRAINAGE SYSTEM AND INFRASTRUCTURE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE FORT BEND COUNTY DRAINAGE CRITERIA MANUAL WILL BE NECESSARY.
21. ANY FUTURE ON-SITE DRAINAGE INFRASTRUCTURE, INCLUDING DETENTION PONDS, SHALL BE LOCATED WITHIN A DEDICATED DRAINAGE EASEMENT WITH OWNERSHIP AND MAINTENANCE RESPONSIBILITY FULLY ASSUMED BY THE PROPERTY OWNER AND THIS RESPONSIBILITY SHALL TRANSFER TO FUTURE OWNERS UPON SALE OF THE PROPERTY.
22. ANY DEVELOPMENT WITHIN THE PLATTED AREA MUST ENSURE THAT PRE-EXISTING, NATURAL DRAINAGE PATTERNS AND CAPACITIES OF NEIGHBORING PROPERTIES ARE NOT NEGATIVELY IMPACTED. IN ADDITION, ALL FUTURE DETENTION OUTFALL LOCATIONS MUST MAINTAIN THE NATURAL, PRE-EXISTING DRAINAGE PATTERNS OF THE SITE.

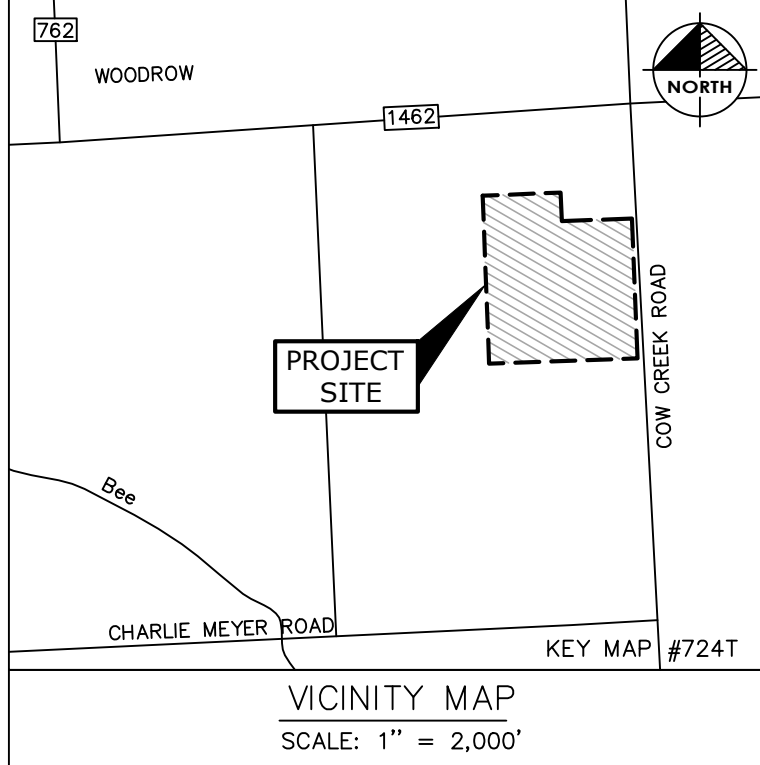
