



INTERVIEW WITH THE SELLERS

1. Why did you decide to buy this home for yourself?

We already lived in this neighborhood - and loved being here - and we wanted to be able to expand to have more room for our family. We looked for a house with a good underlying structure and a larger lot. This spot on Laurenhurst Court was perfect. This home was the home of the original architect of the neighborhood; he had picked a much larger lot and had built the house on piers that would allow us to expand up and out beautifully. We purposefully built the home to fit the style of the neighborhood with craftsman details although the home is significantly more spacious and grand.

2. What do you think are the best features of your home?

My favorite feature is the stacked stone fireplace wall that extends to both stories of the house.
