Without a doubt we can serve gas to your location. However the cost to install the main line would be approximately \$40 per linear foot of pipe. Keep in mind the main line would need to be installed in a Public Utility Easement or Right of Way which is typically next to the roadway. We cannot run cross country or thru another property. We can only install our main along the roadway. Once we get to your property we would then install a service line to your house.

We're in the very early stages of building a house right now, we just got the lot of record that gave us the thumbs up to build a single family home. So we're not quite sure how far everything would need to be ran. If we could get a will-service letter just stating that we'd need to run a new main and then to our future house that would be great. Do you have a super rough estimate like total ballpark number that we won't hold you to? We're currently getting all the utility will-service letters for financing. The parcel number is 00-0007-5346. If we have the letter that says we're within your service area and we'd just need to run another main and run a line to the house from there then we should be good to go and we can figure out the rest when we have a site plan if that makes sense?
